The County Health Department serves all area residents. Services include scheduled immunizations, blood pressure checks and disease investigation.

A reminder from the Jefferson County Health Department. Flu season is here. A flu shot is the best defense for preventing influenza. A flu shot is recommended for anyone over six months of age. It only takes a few minutes to get vaccinated and can prevent many days of illness. Most insurances pay for a flu shot. Schedule your flu shot today with your local health department. Brett Lian: “Jeffco Geographic” “A county and its boundaries are human construct. Sometimes they are based on Earth’s features, like a divide between watersheds or a river, and other times they are based on our imaginary partitions – such as townships or the lines of the graticule. Ultimately, county boundaries are jurisdictional in nature and define the rights, responsibilities, and interests on the land.”

The Jefferson County Parks, Trails and Recreation Commission serves as an advisory/working board to the County Commission and to the Jefferson County Planning Board on matters related to park areas, trails and recreation within Jefferson County. The Parks, Trails, and Recreation Commission consists of seven individuals appointed by the County Commission and receive no compensation.
